Zusammenfassung

This international research project explores for the first time the working methods and techniques of European contemporary fashion designers. A special focus lies on the networks of the designers and their interdisciplinary approaches which are recorded and analysed. Unit F büro für mode will cover the Vienna-based and Austrian designers.
